Scott Paul Selections is the import company that Scott Wright started in 2005. He spends eight weeks a year in Champagne and Burgundy and hand picks great wines whether it is an established superstar or the next generation of rising stars. When Scott picks a Burgundy wine to import he must love the wine and love the people that make it. He states "I'm on a mission to bring the best of Burgundy to America. I personally taste and select every wine that we import and sell. I only bring in wines grown and made by people who are committed to the highest quality and attention to detail."

These are wines that he passionately believes in. Authentic wines made by real people. He searches for true values in wine considering the appellation and the price point. As he would say he wants to offer "the best bang for your buck in the burgundy book, period."

CHAMPAGNE

Champagne Bruno Gobillard

The Gobillards have been growers since the 1700s, and Paul Gobillard, Bruno's great-great grandfather, bottled their first Champagne under their own label in 1858. Today they own a little over 17 acres in the villages around Epernay, scattered over 27 different parcels in the villages of Moussy, Pierry, Epernay, Cramant, Chatillon sur Marne, and la Chapelle Monaudon. Bruno Gobillard took over in 1994, and has quickly risen to cult status among Champagne lovers everywhere. He continues to use the old-school vertical wooden press, and sells off the grapes from his younger vines to keep the vine age and quality the highest for his own production. The wines get a minimum of 4 years on the lees prior to disgorgement, and are generally a blend of 45% Pinot Noir, 45% Chardonnay, and 10% Pinot Meunier. His Vieilles Vignes bottling is revered as perhaps the greatest value in world-class Champagne – availability of which is of course extremely limited.

Champagne Camille Savès

The domaine was created in 1894, and the fourth generation of family ownership is represented by Hervé Savès, who replaced his father Camille in 1982. They have 25 Grand Cru acres in three of Champagne's most important villages – Bouzy, Ambonnay and Tours-sur-Marne. All of the wines are fermented in enamel-lined steel tanks, but then go into a combination of steel tanks and neutral Oak for ageing, before the 2nd fermentation in bottle. All are a minimum of four years on the lees, and malolactic fermentation is blocked for all wines. The style is based on crisp minerality & fresh, biscuit-laced fruit. There is an extra dimension of citrus cutting through, making these wines of great finesse with rich fruit lurking just beneath the surface. The Savès wines have developed a strong cult-like following in recent years.

Champagne José Dhondt

Growers in Champagne for generations, José Dhondt did not produce their first cuvee under their own label until 1974. They own 15 Grand Cru acres in the village of Oger, producing intensely stony, minerally Blanc de Blancs Champagnes that have developed legions of fans over the last 35 years. Winemaking here is very traditional, including the use of a wooden vertical press. Chemicals are kept to the bare minimum in the vineyards, and the sorting is rigorous. The oldest vines, from a parcel in Oger planted in the early 1950s by José's grandfather, are kept separate for a bottling called "Mes Vieilles Vignes", which is vintage dated only in exceptional years.

Champagne Marc Chauvet-Rilly-la-Montagne

Based in the tiny village of Rilly-la-Montagne, the Chauvets have been making Champagne here since 1529. Winemaker Clotilde Chauvet and her viticulturist brother Nicolas are putting the family's 479 years of experience into every bottle produced from their 32 acre estate on the Montagne de Reims. They produce non-vintage Brut cuvees that are generally 2/3 Pinot Noir and 1/3 Chardonnay, and vintage bottlings that are about 70% Chardonnay. The style is refined, clean, bright and intensely flavorful.

Vincent Carré

The Carré family has been growing grapes in the Montagne de Reims village of Trépail since the late 1800s. Michel Carré began bottling their own production in 1959, and his son Vincent took over the domaine in the late 1980s. They own 51.9 acres in Trépail, a village that is unusual for the Montagne de Reims and that is better suited to Chardonnay rather than the Pinot Noir that predominates the region. 90% of their production is Chardonnay, with the remaining 10% in Pinot Noir. Carré produces only 3,500 cases per year, as they sell off a lot of their fruit to the negociant houses, retaining only the best of each vintage for their own production. The wines are hand-crafted and pure, showcasing detailed flavors and a delicate touch.

Guy de Chassey

This tiny, 23.5-acre estate has been in the family since the early 1800s. They're based in the Grand Cru village of Louvois, where they grow both Chardonnay and Pinot Noir, the latter making up 70% of their production. Madame de Chassey took control back in 1993, and is now joined by her son Vincent in the winery. The house style here is to block the malolactic fermentation, with the resulting wines showing a pure and finely chiseled edge. Riddling and disgorging is still done by hand at de Chassey — the old-school methods that show a superior attention to detail. Total annual production is a scant 4,000 cases.

Jacques Picard

The vineyards in Champagne's Monte de Berru region were completely destroyed in World War I — the vineyards were in fact on the front line for much of the war. It was not until after WWII that Roger Picard replanted the area, with 40 acres of vines in the villages of Beru, Montbré and Avenay Val d'Or. Many other families followed suit and replanted in the area after the war, but Picard remains the only Grower-Producer in the region. The Picard estate is planted 70% to Chardonnay, 10% to Pinot Noir and 20% to Pinot Meunier. One of the larger Grower-Producers, they bottle about 12,000 cases per year, with a style focused on richness of fruit and overall balance.

BURGUNDY

Bonneau du Martray

Bonneau du Martray holds the distinction of being the one and only domaine in Burgundy to produce exclusively Grand Cru wines (as even DRC now produces and sells some 1er Cru from vintage to vintage.) Established in the wake of the French revolution at the end of the 1700s, the domaine owns a staggering 27.17 acres of the best part of the Corton hill, all in one contiguous parcel. While they have 3.7 acres of Corton Rouge on the lower portion of the slope, they are known around the world for their magnificent Corton-Charlemagne, perhaps the most powerful and long-lived of Burgundy's Grand Cru whites.

For those who enjoy very pure, elegant and intense white burgundies, Buisson-Charles should be on your list. The wines are clearly built with the express intention of long aging potential." Comte Armand

Domaine Comte Armand in Pommard has been under the ownership of the same family in an unbroken line since before the French revolution, an extreme rarity in Burgundy. Until 1994 the domaine owned only one vineyard, their famous 13-acre Monopole Clos des Epeneaux — an outstanding 1er Cru in Pommard. The current Comte Armand — Vicomte Gabriel Armand, is a Parisian lawyer who has continued the family tradition of relying on resident-managers, or regisseurs, to conduct all of the domaine's affairs.

Domaine J-J Confuron — Premeaux

One of Burgundy's most highly-regarded estates, the 20 acres of *Domaine Jean-Jacques Confuron* is now controlled by *Sophie Meunier-Confuron* and her husband *Alain Meunier*, who work together as a team in the vineyards and the cellar. They took over from *Sophie's* father in 1988, and converted all parcels to organic viticulture in 1990. The wines are brilliant examples of the concept of "power without weight", with great depth of flavors wrapped up in refinement and elegance. The entire range is outstanding here — the *Côte de Nuits-Villages* is a tremendous value for the quality, and their *Romanée-Saint Vivant* is a reference standard for one of the most refined of all Grand Crus.

Frédéric Gueguen/Domaine des Chenevières— Chablis

Young *Frédéric Gueguen* is the son-in-law of Chablis star *Jean-Marc Brocard*, and he started his own domaine in 2003. He was fortunate to be able to purchase a collection of superbly situated old-vine parcels (dating to 1928), with lovely pieces of village-level Chablis as well as the 1er Cru *Côte de Lechet*, *Fourchaume*, and the rarely seen *l'Homme Mort*. As is traditional in Chablis, the wines are fermented and aged 100% in stainless steel — he uses absolutely no oak whatsoever. The wines are totally pure expressions of the unique and powerful terroirs of France's most northerly still-wine grape growing region. Domaine Huber-Verdereau — Volnay

"The young and very talented *Thiebault Huber*, who is something of a protégé of *Jean-Pierre Charlot* (of *Domaine Joseph Voillot*), is from Alsace and is a former sommelier. 1994 was his first harvest in Burgundy as he started with only 3 ha but now exploits 6.5 in 11 different appellations. He started farming **biodynamically** in 2002 and the entire estate is now Demeter-certified biodynamic. *Thiebault's* wines from *Volnay*, *Pommard* and *Puligny-Montrachet* are dense, concentrated, vibrant and alive with complex flavors and aromas, and tend to blossom over many years in the bottle. "The *Huber-Verdereau* wines are by far the most interesting discovery I made on this trip and I highly recommend them to you. Michel Lafarge

A family estate created at the start of the 1800s, *Domaine Michel Lafarge* is quite simply the source of some of the most sublime wines in all of Burgundy. Their bottlings are often the benchmarks of the vintage, and are sought after by passionate collectors worldwide. *Michel* took over from his father in 1949, and now has seen over 60 vintages under his control — making him one of Burgundy's most experienced and respected elder statesmen. He was joined by his son *Frédéric* in 1978, and they have worked jointly ever since.

Leroux, who completed his tenth harvest at *Pommard's Domaine Comte Armand* in 2008 and continues to make the wines there, has a new project — a négociant operation in which he buys fruit from other growers. He did a little *negoce* activity at *Comte Armand*, but that has now ceased; he continues to use some of those sources in this new, separate endeavor, his own label simply called *Benjamin Leroux*.

Domaine Jean-Marc Millot — Nuits St.-Georges

The winery and cellars are in ancient Nuits St.-Georges, and Jean-Marc Millot's 17 acres of vineyard holdings are concentrated in Vosne-Romanée, Vougeot, and Echezeaux. Jean-Marc took over the domaine in 1990, but has had most of the Grand Cru sites since only 1998 (his wife was an heir to the old Louis Gouroux domaine.) His wines are the epitome of elegance, purity, and understatement, with a beautiful sense of finesse, harmony and overall balance.

Many of our producers go back 7 or 8 generations. Domaine Ninot goes back to 1313! Yes, that's 1313 — as in the middle ages — a mere 695 years ago. Erell is an energetic dynamo, in full charge of all viticulture and winemaking for the 29 acre estate. Erell keeps her yields low (about 2 tons to the acre for the Pinot, under three tons for the Chardonnay), and uses a judiciously small amount of new oak — an average of about 10-15%. The wines are supple and vibrant and pure and quite simply a delight.

For multiple generations the Pavelots have been among the leading producers in Savigny-lès-Beaune, a picturesque village just north of Beaune and below the flanks of the hill of Corton. Jean-Marc and his son Hugues now run the domaine in tandem, with Hugues having joined in 1999. They own just under 30 acres in Savigny, Pernand-Vergelesses and Beaune, spread across dozens of small parcels. They produce both red & white village wines from Savigny, and a total of eight different 1er Crus — each of which has its own distinct personality.

Chateau des Rontets

Perched high atop the Mâconnais village of Fuissé, Chateau des Rontets is a rarity among Burgundian domaines in that virtually all of their 15 acres are one walled-in vineyard, the magnificent **Clos Varambon**. The vineyard and modest chateau have been in the family of Claire Gazeau since 1850. Claire and her husband Fabio took over the estate in the late 90s. They are blessed with several parcels of very old vines, with several sections of the clos planted between 1910-1920. They produce three different cuvées of Pouilly-Fuissé each vintage — one from just the oldest vines, another from several different parcels planted from 1945-1975, and the third from a single parcel just outside the walls. Just down the road, they own 1.22 acres in Saint-Amour, with Gamay vines planted in 1970. Saint-Amour is one of the most elegant of the prestigious Crus of Beaujolais.

Domaine Anne & Hervé Sigaut — Chambolle-Musigny

The Sigauts have been passionately but quietly making gorgeous wines in the tiny village of Chambolle-Musigny for generations. The secret is out and the quiet is about to be a thing of the past. The estate totals 17 acres, including spectacular old-vine parcels of Chambolle 1er Cru Les Fuées, Les Sentiers and Noirots — many of which are plowed by horse. The winemaking facility was re-built in 2004, with a sorting table, all stainless-steel fermentation tanks, and full temperature control. New oak is kept to a maximum of 40%. The wines are thoroughbred examples of the magnificent terroirs of Chambolle-Musigny. Recently the 2006 Sentiers was listed as one of the Wine Spectator's 'hot wines'.

Domaine Thibert Pere et Fils — Maconnais

Christophe Thibert and his sister Sandrine are now at the helm of this venerable 60 acre estate in the Mâconnais. The Mâcon region is home to some of the greatest-value white wine appellations in all of Burgundy, and the Thiberts have extensive holdings in St. Veran, Mâcon, and Pouilly-Fuissé, including some old-vine parcels over 85 years old. The vineyards are now organic, all fruit is picked by hand (not a universal practice in this region), & the wines are hallmarked by their intensity, purity and length. These wines often blow away many Côte de Beaune whites at a fraction of the price.

Domaine Taupenot-Merme — Morey-St. Denis

At nearly 30 acres, Domaine Taupenot-Merme is a rather large estate by Burgundian standards. The roots of the family estate go back to the 1760, and today's superb vineyard holdings in Gevrey-Chambertin, Morey-St. Denis and Chambolle Musigny were united by the marriage of two winemaking families three generations ago. Now in the hands of 41 year-old Romain Taupenot and his sister Virginie, 36, they are the 7th generation to continue the family tradition. Parcels include significant pieces of both Charmes Chambertin & Mazoyères Chambertin and a great line-up of 1er cru including Combe d'Orveau in Chambolle-Musigny. All farming is organic and the wine style here is one of elegance and purity, with a base of finesse rather than power. The wines are superb with food, and are excellent values.

Total production for each wine is only 500 cases! The CDR is also about 80% Grenache with Cinsault & Syrah. Average vine age is 40 years. No fining, no filtration, and organic farming. These are big, rich, complex, ageworthy wines with ripe fruit and plenty of tannin. The long lasting "bag in box" is a sensational deal.
