#### Domaine J-J Confuron - Premaux

*At nearly 30 acres, Domaine Taupenot-Merme is a rather large estate by Burgundian standards. The roots of the family estate go back to the 1760s, and today's superb vineyard holdings in Gevrey--Chambertin, Morey-St. Denis and Chambolle Musigny were united by the marriage of two winemaking families three generations ago. Now in the hands of 41 year-old Romain Taupenot and his sister Virginie, 36, they are the 7th generation to continue the family tradition. All farming is organic, and the winemaking is traditional and pure.*
